*Socrates =Fundamental Principles in the Crito*

P1: We must always act on the basis of good reasons and good reasoning, not out of fear, mere self-interest, etc.

P1(a): We value the opinions only of those who know, not of the many.

P1(b): The principles on which we rely must stand the tests of time and change of circumstance, and the conclusions which we draw from them must be ones to which we can be constantly faithful.

P2: It is not enough to live; we must live well, i.e., nobly and justly.

P3: We must never do wrong willingly, even in requital.

P4: We must always keep our agreements, provided they are just.
